

I have elsewhere expressed the opinion that it is unnecessary to suture the spinal membranes in the majority of instances. I have followed out the idea in a number of cases without cause for regret. It applies to operations for spina bifida as well as to other procedures. The remnants of the sac fold into a mass which plugs the opening and is held in place by the covering of wire, and adhesions soon take place which render sutures superfluous. A certain amount of danger of catgut infection is thus avoided, and considerable valuable time saved. Dr. H. O. Marcy insists on the value of the Trendelenburg position, asserting that gravity will materially assist in the prevention of the escape of cerebro-spinal fluid. This seems to be open to question, to say the least. The fluid is contained in a rigid tube, closed everywhere, except at its lower end, just as if it were within a pipette with a finger over the upper opening. The only way it can run out is by depression of a fontanelle, which cannot displace a great quantity, or by entrance of blood into the cavity to take its place. In the Trendelenburg position the flow of blood into the skull would be greatly facilitated, and I am inclined to believe that the loss of cerebro-spinal fluid would perhaps be greater in this position than in any other.
